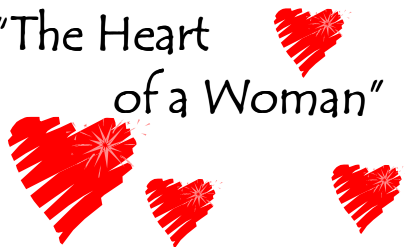

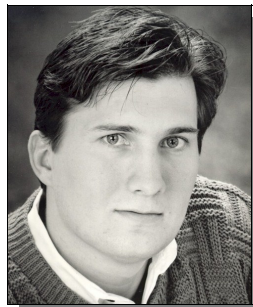
Linda Strom—Keynote Speaker



Linda and her husband, Dallas, were married in 1963; they often describe the early months of their marriage as stormy since Linda brought the pain of her broken childhood into their lives. However, after they each gave their lives to Jesus Christ in 1963, God placed a call on their lives and they became youth workers at their church. In 1974, they co-founded Discipleship Limited, Inc.; after experiencing Christ's healing presence in their marriage, they began ministering together at conferences and seminars. In 1976, they began teaching marriage seminars and leading prison retreats. For over 20 years, Linda also led an interdenominational Bible study.

In the 1980s, the Stroms began bringing volunteer teams to the women prison inmates in Gatesville, Texas, where they developed relationships with all the women at the prison, including those on death row. Karla Faye Tucker asked Linda to be her spiritual advisor before Karla's execution in 1998. Linda is now writing a book describing Karla's relationship with Jesus Christ and the resulting impact on each life Karla encountered.

Klaus Kuehn— Praise and Worship



Klaus has a passion and a unique touch on his life to bring people into the presence of God. He has been active in leading worship in the local church for the past 10 years and is a member of
